President's Corner

Hello SPER friends and colleagues!

In just a few weeks, we will be gathering in Chicago for our first in-person annual meeting since 2019! We have a **COVID protocol** in place that we think will keep everyone as safe as possible. It includes obtaining a negative test before arriving at the conference (free tests provided), proof of vaccination status, and encouragement to wear a mask:



SPER asks all attendees to obtain a negative SARS-CoV-2 test before arriving at the conference. To facilitate this, SPER has partnered with <u>eMed</u> to provide free testing kits for you to test in advance of the conference and each day of the conference. **To receive this test, you must sign up by May 31, 2022 using this link:** https://epiresearch.org/request/.

The details are as follows:

<u>eMed</u> is a digital CLIA certified laboratory that proctors at-home tests, on-demand 24/7 and provides an encrypted digital CLIA laboratory report to the user, via email, in minutes after use (and as a CLIA laboratory automatically provides public health reporting of results).

eMed will ship you one test to take before traveling to the conference. You should test no more than 24 hours before arriving. We require a negative test result from your eMed kit to check in at the conference. The eMed test includes an official Lab Report which you should provide as proof at check in (printed or readable on a mobile device). Please note that the process of testing may take 30 minutes to obtain your result, so allow adequate time.

To ensure your free test is shipped to your preferred address anywhere in the world in time for the conference, **please complete this form by May 31**: https://epiresearch.org/request/. If you are attending SPER and SER, you only need to complete this form once.

SPER also requires proof of full vaccination status. Please bring your vaccination card and ID to show upon check-in.

SPER encourages all participants to wear a mask in public areas of the conference.

The meeting we have put together will be outstanding, and we are so excited to finally see each other's faces (at least one-third of our faces!).
